2024 Ag Scholarship Application



The Newberry Soil and Water Conservation District (NSWCD) will be awarding two \$1,000.00 scholarships to a graduating senior or current college student from Newberry County. The scholarship checks will be written directly to the college/university the student plans to attend.

These students must be already attending or planning to attend and have been accepted by a college, university, or technical college to pursue a degree in agriculture, wildlife biology, forestry, Ag education, environmental natural resources field, or any related field, in the fall of 2023.

All applications must be mailed to or dropped off at the Newberry Soil and Water Conservation District office located in the USDA Service Center at 719 Kendall Road, Newberry, SC 29108. This year email applications will be accepted to Newberrysoilandwater@gmail.com, NSWCD also offers as a fillable .pdf version to be completed online at their website www.newberyswcd.com. Please answer all short answer questions on a separate typed document. Answers should be double spaced 12-point Calibri or Arial font.

The deadline for all applications will be midnight of Friday, April 19th, 2024. Applications will not be accepted after this deadline. Winners will be chosen anonymously by April 26th, 2024.

Completed application should include the following for full consideration:

- 1) Application Form (attached)
- 2) Answers to the Short Answers Questions (attached)
- 3) Answer to the Essay Question
- 4) Most Recent High School or College Transcript (unofficial transcripts are allowed)
- 5) Copy of College Acceptance Letter (for High School Students) or Enrollment Letter (for current College/University students). Letter must contain student ID number.
